

The Healing Hands Foundation traveled to Cali, Colombia from February 19th to the 27th with over 75 volunteers from the U.S.A. and over 200 Colombian volunteers from "*Manos Unidas de Colombia Foundation*". Working together this medical mission was a success. The volunteers were able to perform over 600 surgeries, nearly 1000 dental procedures and about 7,773 medical consultations in 6 days. The volunteers were able to perform all this work in five different hospitals (Hospital Universitario del Valle, Fundacion Valle del Lili, Institute for the Deaf and the Blind, Isaias Duarte Cancino, and Carlos Carmona).

Our volunteers were also able to work together with local doctors and train nurses, medical students and residents. This is a major milestone accomplished and one of our goals that was set when THHF was founded. With the help of all the volunteers we were able to donate close to \$1M in medical equipment, medicine and supplies. We are also in the process of creating an exchange medical program between the Hospital Universitario del Valle from Cali and Johns Hopkins Hospital in the field of Plastic Surgery.
